Section 1: Identification

Product Name: Magic Powder Mixture (1L, 3L, 5L, 25L & 50L pack sizes)
Ingredients: Poly (ethylene oxide), Sucrose
Recommended Use: Use as directed on packet (to be mixed with fairy liquid and water to create giant bubble solution).

Section 2: Hazard(s) Identification

Hazard Classification: Slip Hazard.

Signal Word: Warning

Hazard Statements: Spilled powder (when mixed with water/other liquids) on floor/ground becomes extremely slippery.



Precautionary Statements:

- 1) We recommend that you protecting the area around your bubble solution tub/bucket, perhaps with a towel to soak up little splashes, or we would highly recommend a waterproofed backed picnic blanket. (Never machine wash solution-soaked fabric, hose down/hand wash only). ***You can also put your tub/bucket inside a larger tub, this helps catch the excess and reduces slip and spill hazards dramatically.**
- 2) Don't make bubbles in the same area for a long period of time, move locations if a long time is required to avoid the buildup of slippery splashes and spills.
- 3) Clean up spillages immediately, clean floors & surfaces after use. Be aware the ground/floor will become slippery during use, avoid running, stop activities & clean if area becomes soiled.
- 4) Keep out of reach of children
- 5) All bubble activities should be supervised by a responsible adult.

Hazard Classification: Skin Irritation

Signal Word: Warning

Hazard Statements: When powder is mixed with fairy liquid, prolonged use of bubble solution may cause skin irritation.



Precautionary Statements:

- 1) All bubble activities should be supervised by a responsible adult.

2) Wash hands after making bubbles, or every 30mins/1 hour if making bubbles for a long period of time. Use gloves if your hands have sensitive skin.

Hazard Classification: Eye Irritation

Signal Word: Warning

Hazard Statements: When the powder is mixed with fairy liquid it causes serious eye irritation



Precautionary Statements: 1) IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing - If eye irritation persists: Get medical advice/attention.

2) Keep out of reach of children.

3) All bubble activities should be supervised by a responsible adult.

4) Avoid using bubble wands over children's heads, to avoid drips into eyes.

Hazard Classification: When the powder is mixed with fairy liquid.

Signal Word: Warning

Hazard Statements: Fairy Liquid is harmful to aquatic life with long lasting effects



Precautionary Statements: 1) Dispose of unused bubble solution to an appropriate local waste system. Down the sink or drain.

2) Keep out of reach of children

3) All bubble activities should be supervised by a responsible adult.

4) Use appropriate grass protection around your bubble bucket/tub when bubbling on grass.

Section 4: First-Aid Measures

This applies as powder and when mixed with fairy liquid and water.

After skin contact: IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of water and soap. Take off contaminated clothing and clean before reuse. If skin irritation or rash occurs: Get medical advice/attention. Discontinue use of product.

After eye contact: IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Immediately call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician.

After inhalation: IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician if exposed or you feel unwell.

After swallowing: Ingestion IF SWALLOWED: Rinse mouth. DO NOT induce vomiting. Immediately call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician.

Most important symptoms and effects, both acute and delayed:

Symptoms/injuries: After inhalation Coughing. Sneezing.

Symptoms/injuries after skin contact Redness. Swelling. Dryness. Itching.

Symptoms/injuries after eye contact Severe pain. Redness. Swelling. Blurred vision.

Symptoms/injuries after ingestion Oral mucosa

Section 5: Fire-Fighting Measures

Suitable extinguishing agents: CO₂, dry chemical media, water

Special protective equipment for firefighters: None

Unusual fire and Explosion Hazards: Avoid dispersion of powder dust in the air to reduce potential explosion hazard. Dust is easily ignited; avoid ignition sources.

Section 6: Accidental Release Measures

SPILL OR LEAK PROCEDURES: Steps to be taken in case powder is released or spilled: Sweep or vacuum up. Avoid mixing with water on floor. This combination is very slippery. If spilled once mixed with fairy liquid & water then outdoors – hose/clean the area down thoroughly. If indoors – Use a towel, newspaper, paper towels to soak up the liquid. (Never machine wash solution-soaked fabric, hose down/hand wash only).

Section 7: Handling and Storage

Handling: Avoid contact with eyes. Use personal protective equipment as required. Do not eat, drink or smoke when using this product. Do not handle until all safety precautions have been read and understood. Wash hands after use. Slippery when wet.

Storage: Store powder in bag at room temperature.

Store solution in an airtight and waterproof/sealed container.

Store powder and solution away from children and animals.

*Do not store and keep old bubble solution, as this will cause Mold growth. Only keep for 1-2 weeks maximum once mixed up with fairy liquid and water. *

Section 8: Exposure Controls/Personal Protection

Personal protective equipment: Protective personal equipment like gloves only required in case of professional use or when you will be in contact with bubble solution for long periods of time.

For consumer use: please follow recommendation as indicated on the label of the product.

Eye Protection: Wear eye/face protection.

Respiratory Protection: Use a dust respirator (if dusts are present).

For when mixed with fairy liquid: Environmental exposure controls Prevent that the product reaches surface waters.

***Do not store and keep old bubble solution, as this will cause Mold growth. Only keep for 1-2 weeks maximum once mixed up with fairy liquid and water. ***
